

## Configuring Mac Operating System 9.0

You will also need the following account details, supplied to you by FunnelWeb Internet:

- Your UserName
- Your Password

### Let's start...

#### 1. Set up the Connection Icon:

Open the Macintosh HD, double click the "Internet" option, then select "Internet Setup Assistant".

Click "Update" to continue.

Next click "Add", then the right arrow to add a new configuration (or Modify if you're altering an existing one).

Name your connection "FunnelWeb Internet", then click the right arrow to continue.

Select your modem from the list – if your modem does not appear, the 3Com Analog 14.4K is a generic one for 14.4K modems, and the Hayes Optima/Accura 28.8K is likely to work for 28.8K modems. Specify the correct port for your modem (usually Modem Port), and "Tone" for the kind of dialling. Then click the right arrow to continue.

The Internet Setup Assistant will now ask for the phone number to dial, your UserName and your password. Enter the Username and password as provided, and enter 0198 333 898 for the phone number. Click the right arrow.

You may be asked to use a PPP login script, select "No" if it is not already selected and click the right arrow to continue.

Next you will be asked for your IP. Leave it on 'No IP' and click the right arrow.

Now set up the Domain Name Server and Domain Name.

The Primary DNS is 203.55.94.15, and the Secondary DNS is 203.24.218.12.


The domain name should be [funnelwebinternet.com.au](http://funnelwebinternet.com.au). Then click the right arrow.

The next screen shows the E-mail Address and Password request boxes - your e-mail address is [username@funnelwebinternet.com.au](mailto:username@funnelwebinternet.com.au), and your password is the one supplied. Click the right arrow to continue.

Now you must enter your POP and SMTP server. Your POP account is your UserName, and the POP server address is pop.fwi.net.au. The address for the SMTP server should be smtp.fwi.net.au.

Then click the right arrow. Enter your News (NNTP) Server – news.comindico.com.au and click the right arrow.

Now you will be asked if you wish to use a proxy server, select yes and click the next arrow. In the following screen, make sure that the “HTTP” tick box is ticked, Under “Host”, type cache.truenorth.net.au, and under “Port” type the number 80. Click the next arrow to continue.

Now all you have to do in order to connect to the Internet is click  icon in your control strip, and once connected start your web browser!
